

Ms. Jeanne C. Crawmer, Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission (MPOETC) Instructor, Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC), Harrisburg, PA

Jeanne Crawmer retired in 2015 from the West Manchester Township Police Department in York, PA as a Sergeant after 33 years of service. She was responsible for the daily supervision of a patrol platoon and oversaw the assignment of all overtime scheduling. In addition, she took on the added responsibility of overseeing the education and training of all officers and Department staff for several years. She developed and instituted the first formalized Field Training Program utilized by the Department and later assisted with the transition and implementation of updating the Field Training Program as the FTO Coordinator/Supervisor.

While still working for West Manchester Twp P.D., Jeanne volunteered for a course development team with the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC) in 2000 to assist with developing an in-service course on Supervision. MPOETC is the equivalent of POST in most states. Shortly thereafter, she was hired by Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) to instruct MPOETC sanctioned courses for Municipal Police Officers and Academy Cadets. In addition to teaching for HACC, she co-wrote and instructs courses in Critical Incident Management and Field Training Officer (FTO). Jeanne continues to teach police officers, cadets, and others involved in the criminal justice system across Pennsylvania today.

Education has always been an important component in Jeanne's life. In 1981, she obtained a Bachelor of Science degree from York College of Pennsylvania in Police Science, and in 2000 she obtained a Master's degree from Villanova in Criminal Justice Administration.
