Sandy Myers develops online learning courses for the PA Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, designs and provides classroom professional development and leadership courses, and reviews and evaluates course content for out-service training taken by the 2500 employees of the agency.

Sandy previously worked as the eLearning Developer for Pennsylvania's Municipal Police Education & Training Commission (MPOETC), where she co-developed classroom and online courses for the police academies throughout Pennsylvania. During Sandy's tenure at MPOETC, she helped deliver the first state-wide online courses for mandatory in-service training. Sandy also partnered with the Pennsylvania State Police to develop online learning for the Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program (MCSAP), where she was awarded a commendation for saving the agency \$50,000 in estimated training delivery costs.

Prior to her work with Pennsylvania POST agency, MPOETC, Sandy worked for the PA Governor's Office of Administration as an eLearning Developer and as the assistant director of the Leadership Development Institute. She started her career as an IT specialist, programming mainframe logistics systems and assisting with the development of a major database for the US Navy. Sandy transitioned from IT into training and education, and uses her technical expertise to break new ground in providing meaningful, applicable training through technology.
